- RCW 2.30.110 Early childhood court programs—Judicial officer training. (1) Judicial officers who preside over early childhood court program hearings shall participate in required trainings, as follows:
- (a) An initial, eight-hour training program that can include the topic areas of:
- (i) The benefits to infants and toddlers of secure attachment with primary caregivers;
  - (ii) A trauma-informed approach;
- (iii) The importance of maintaining children within their biological connections;
- (iv) The importance of reunification of children with their families;
  - (v) Diversity, equity, and inclusion; and
  - (vi) The impact of trauma on child development;
- (b) After the initial training, annually attend a minimum of eight hours of continuing education of pertinence to the early childhood court program.
- (2) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this specific purpose, the administrative office of the courts shall administer the certification of training requirements. [2021 c 285 s 3.]
