- RCW 2.42.150 Waiver of right to interpreter. (1) The right to a qualified interpreter may not be waived except when:
- (a) A hearing impaired person requests a waiver through the use of a qualified interpreter;
- (b) The counsel, if any, of the hearing impaired person consents; and
- (c) The appointing authority determines that the waiver has been made knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently.
- (2) Waiver of a qualified interpreter shall not preclude the hearing impaired person from claiming his or her right to a qualified interpreter at a later time during the proceeding, program, or activity. [1985 c 389 s 15.]
