- RCW 28A.420.120 Consistent effect and conflict with other state laws. (1) Nothing herein shall prevent or inhibit the enforcement of any other law of a member state that is not inconsistent with the compact.
- (2) Any laws, statutes, regulations, or other legal requirements in a member state in conflict with the compact are superseded to the extent of the conflict.
- (3) All permissible agreements between the commission and the member states are binding in accordance with their terms. [2024 c 317 s 13.]
