Dear Representative Fey and Senator Liias:

The Washington State Patrol is required to report to the Transportation Committees of the Legislature and the Office of Financial Management by December 1 of each year, on the level of the fees that have been adopted and whether those fees are sufficient to cover the cost of performing the duties of the Ignition Interlock Program (RCW 43.43.396).

Rules allowing us to charge fees were effective October 1, 2012, and the fee schedule was set as follows:

Title of Fee	Amount
Initial Device Certification	\$1,000
Annual Device Certification Renewal	\$500
Installation Verification Form	\$10
Monthly Monitoring Calibration	\$5
Initial Service Center Certification	\$250
Annual Service Center Certification Renewal	\$75
Initial Ignition Interlock Technician Certification	\$50
Ignition Interlock Technician Certification Renewal	\$25



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Fees are sufficient to cover the costs of the Ignition Interlock Program. The following table shows revenue and the expenditures for the current and prior biennia, as well as the cumulative total.
