EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The 2023 Washington State Legislature enacted Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5187, the 2023-25 Operating Budget which provides:

\$150,000 of the general fund—state appropriation for fiscal year 2024 is provided solely for the department to conduct an assessment of wireless internet implementation needs and options.

The proviso also requires the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) to include an assessment of satellite and fiber options and submit a report with this information to the appropriate committees of the legislature by December 15, 2023.

Unrelated to the funded proviso in the 2023-25 Operating Budget, DSHS moved forward with an Electronic Health Record (EHR) readiness project in Fiscal Year 2023 (FY23) to prepare the Department to move to a future EHR solution. Part of the EHR readiness project was an assessment to determine the Wi-Fi needs for the Special Commitment Center (SCC), which occurred prior to receiving funds in the 2023-25 operating budget.

Work Completed in Fiscal Year 2023

SCC was able to complete the following items associated with Wi-Fi as part of the EHR readiness project:

- Wi-Fi assessment by WaTech
- Wireless Access Point (WAP) identification/needs
- Procurement of WAPs
- Installation of Conduit, Cabling and Power

Remaining Activities to be Completed in Fiscal Year 2024

The two remaining steps for functional Wi-Fi at SCC are the installation of enclosures and installation of WAPs. The timeline for the wiring, staging, install, testing and go-live began on Tuesday, November 28, 2023. The work is expected to be complete with functional Wi-Fi in the 1st quarter of 2024.
