5 On page 25, after line 14 of the amendment, insert the
6 following:

7 "Sec. 15. RCW 26.44.140 and 1990 c 3 s 1301 are each amended
8 to read as follows:

9 The court shall require that an individual who, while acting
10 in a parental role, has physically or sexually abused a child and
11 has been removed from the home pursuant to a court order issued in
12 a proceeding under chapter 13.34 RCW, prior to being permitted to
13 reside in the home where the child resides, complete the treatment
14 and education requirements necessary to protect the child from
15 future abuse. The court may require the individual to continue
16 treatment as a condition for remaining in the home where the child
17 resides.

18 The department of social and health services or supervising
19 agency shall be responsible for advising the court as to
20 appropriate treatment and education requirements, providing
21 referrals to the individual, monitoring and assessing the
22 individual's progress, informing the court of such progress, and
23 providing recommendations to the court.

24 The person removed from the home shall pay for these services
25 (~~according to a schedule established by the department of social~~

1 and health services. This schedule shall be based on the
2 individual's ability to pay)) unless the person is otherwise
3 eligible to receive financial assistance in paying for such
4 services. Nothing in this section shall be construed to create in
5 any person an entitlement to services or financial assistance in
6 paying for services."

7 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal
8 references.
