1 AN ACT Relating to nonresident tuition and fees; and reenacting and
2 amending RCW 28B.15.014.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.014 and 1989 c 306 s 3 and 1989 c 290 s 3 are
5 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

6 The following nonresidents shall be exempted from paying the
7 nonresident tuition and fee differential:

8 (1) Any person who resides in the state of Washington and who holds
9 a graduate service appointment designated as such by a public
10 institution of higher education or is employed for an academic
11 department in support of the instructional or research programs
12 involving not less than twenty hours per week during the term such
13 person shall hold such appointment.

14 (2) Any faculty member, classified staff member or administratively
15 exempt employee holding not less than a half time appointment at an

1 institution who resides in the state of Washington, and the dependent
2 children and spouse of such persons.

3 (3) Active-duty military personnel stationed in the state of
4 Washington and the spouses and dependents of such military personnel.

5 (4) Any immigrant refugee and the spouse and dependent children of
6 such refugee, if the refugee (a) is on parole status, or (b) has
7 received an immigrant visa, or (c) has applied for United States
8 citizenship.

9 (5) Domestic exchange students participating in the program created
10 under RCW 28B.15.725.

11 (6) Any dependent of a member of the United States congress
12 representing the state of Washington.

13 (7) Any dependent whose parent or legal guardian resides in the
14 state of Washington and who entered the state as a result of full-time
15 employment with an employer in this state or a transfer into this state
16 by his or her employer. The dependent must present a signed statement
17 from the parent's or guardian's employer certifying that the parent or
18 guardian entered the state as a result of the employment.
