1 AN ACT Relating to driving with an instruction permit; and amending  
2 RCW 46.20.025.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.025 and 1979 c 75 s 1 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 The following persons are exempt from license hereunder:

7 (1) Any person in the service of the army, navy, air force, marine  
8 corps, or coast guard of the United States, or in the service of the  
9 national guard of this state or any other state, when furnished with a  
10 driver's license by such service when operating an official motor  
11 vehicle in such service;

12 (2) A nonresident who is at least (~~sixteen~~) fifteen years of age  
13 and who has in his immediate possession a valid driver's license or  
14 instruction permit issued to him in his home state;

1           (3) A nonresident who is at least sixteen years of age and who has  
2 in his immediate possession a valid driver's license issued to him in  
3 his home country may operate a motor vehicle in this state for a period  
4 not to exceed one year;

5           (4) Any person operating special highway construction equipment as  
6 defined in RCW 46.16.010;

7           (5) Any person while driving or operating any farm tractor or  
8 implement of husbandry which is only incidentally operated or moved  
9 over a highway;

10          (6) Any person while operating a locomotive upon rails, including  
11 operation on a railroad crossing over a public highway; and such person  
12 is not required to display a driver's license to any law enforcement  
13 officer in connection with the operation of a locomotive or train  
14 within this state.
