1            AN ACT Relating to feeding school children during teachers' work  
2    stoppage; creating new sections; making an appropriation; and declaring  
3    an emergency.

4    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**            The legislature finds that state school  
6    feeding programs are essential to the health and well-being of many  
7    children and that continuing these programs during a teachers' work  
8    stoppage is in the best interests of the state of Washington.

9            The legislature intends to continue to provide food to eligible  
10   children during the teachers' work stoppage, which began on April 18,  
11   1991, in forty-six districts throughout the state.

12           NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**            The superintendent of public instruction  
13   may reimburse school districts with state funds for the amount of any  
14   unavailable federal share of funds for breakfasts or lunches actually

1 provided to children during the teachers' work stoppage that began  
2 April 18, 1991.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The sum of two million dollars, or as  
4 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium  
5 ending June 30, 1991, from the general fund to the superintendent of  
6 public instruction solely for the purpose of section 2 of this act.

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate  
8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
9 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
10 effect immediately.
