1            AN ACT Relating to gasoline vapor recovery at service stations and  
2 other dispensing facilities; adding a new section to chapter 70.94 RCW;  
3 creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**    The legislature finds that the use of  
6 gasoline vapor recovery devices at service stations and other public  
7 dispensing facilities endangers the health and safety of Washington  
8 citizens and should not be required by the state or any air pollution  
9 control authority.

10           NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**    A new section is added to chapter 70.94 RCW  
11 to read as follows:

12           A gasoline vapor recovery device that captures vapors during  
13 vehicle fueling is not required at a service station and at any other  
14 gasoline dispensing facility that supplies fuel to the general public.

15           NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.**    This act is necessary for the immediate  
16 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

1 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
2 effect immediately.
