Brief Description: Providing for flood damage reduction.

HB 1441-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/17/93)

Adopts rules establishing zero-rise floodway by July 1, 1994, for all unincorporated areas designated as within the one hundred year flood plain.

Provides for implementation of a comprehensive flood hazard management plan.

Revises provisions regulating the issuance of permits for food fish and shellfish construction projects in state waters.

Exempts reconstruction of dikes and levees determined by a county to be consistent with a flood hazard management plan from shoreline management provisions.

Requires purchase agreements for real property to provide a warning if the property is within the one hundred year flood plain.

Repeals RCW 86.16.025 and 86.26.090.
