**SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1354**

1 AN ACT Relating to hound permits; and amending RCW 77.12.040 and  
2 77.32.320.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.12.040 and 1987 c 506 s 15 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 The commission shall adopt, amend, or repeal, and enforce  
7 reasonable rules prohibiting or governing the time, place, and manner  
8 of taking or possessing game animals, game birds, or game fish. The  
9 commission may specify the quantities, species, sex, and size of game  
10 animals, game birds, or game fish that may be taken or possessed. The  
11 commission shall regulate the taking, sale, possession, and  
12 distribution of wildlife and deleterious exotic wildlife. The  
13 commission may set pursuit only seasons in which only residents may  
14 participate. The director may adopt emergency rules under RCW  
15 77.12.150.

16 The commission may establish by rule game reserves and closed areas  
17 where hunting for wild animals or wild birds may be prohibited and  
18 closed waters where fishing for game fish may be prohibited.

1       **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.32.320 and 1990 c 84 s 4 are each amended to read  
2 as follows:

3       (1) In addition to a basic hunting license, a separate transport  
4 tag is required to hunt deer, elk, bear, cougar, sheep, mountain goat,  
5 moose, or wild turkey.

6       (2) A transport tag may only be obtained subsequent to the purchase  
7 of a valid hunting license and must have permanently affixed to it the  
8 hunting license number.

9       (3) Persons who kill deer, elk, bear, cougar, mountain goat, sheep,  
10 moose, or wild turkey shall immediately validate and attach their own  
11 transport tag to the carcass as provided by rule of the director.

12       (4) Transport tags required by this section expire on March 31st  
13 following the date of issuance.

14       (5) The commission shall issue nonresident bear tags in a number  
15 not to exceed ten percent of the number of resident bear tags issued  
16 two years prior.
