Read first time 3/7/96.

1            BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of  
2 Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before adjournment  
3 SINE DIE of this 1996 regular session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature:

4            (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all  
5 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and  
6 House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by  
7 the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such  
8 measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third  
9 reading; and

10           (2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all  
11 Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions,  
12 and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed  
13 by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such  
14 measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third  
15 reading; and

16           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the  
17 Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their  
18 possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE  
19 of the 1996 regular session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature, all  
20 legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent  
21 resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be in their

1 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other  
2 documents pertaining thereto; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any special  
4 session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature shall be numbered as a  
5 continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 1996 regular  
6 session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature.
