Brief Description: Increasing penalties for crimes involving methamphetamine.

SB 6182-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/5/96)

Provides that any person who possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine with intent to manufacture methamphetamine may be imprisoned for not more than ten years, fined not more than twenty five thousand dollars, or both.

Provides that any person who creates, delivers, or possesses methamphetamine may be imprisoned for not more than ten years, fined not more than twenty-five thousand dollars, or both.
