5 On page 3, beginning on line 30, strike all material down to and
6 including page 4, line 13, and insert the following:

7 (c) The department shall make temporary accommodations for the
8 displacement of legislators and legislative staff in the John L.
9 O'Brien building, the Pritchard building, the Cherberg building, and
10 the Newhouse building.

11 (d) The department shall temporarily move the state library to the
12 Sunset Life building by June 30, 2001, and, if needed, the department
13 shall lease storage facilities in Thurston county for books and other
14 library assets;

15 (e) The department shall make temporary accommodations for other
16 tenants of the state legislative building as follows:

17 (i) The office of the insurance commissioner shall be moved to
18 leased space in Thurston county;

19 (ii) The office of the governor shall be moved to the Insurance
20 building;

21 (iii) The office of the code reviser and the lieutenant governor
22 shall be moved to a location on the west capitol campus; and

23 (iv) The other tenants, including the office of the state
24 treasurer, the office of the state auditor, and the office of the
25 secretary of state shall be moved to leased space in Thurston county;-
