Read first time 06/04/01 . Under suspension of the rules, read second and third times and adopted.

1 WHEREAS, Bills, joint resolutions, joint memorials, and concurrent  
2 resolutions introduced at the 2001 regular session or the 2001 first  
3 special session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature may require that they  
4 be considered at the 2001 second special session of the Fifty-seventh  
5 Legislature; and

6 WHEREAS, The public interest requires that the business of the 2001  
7 second special session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature be considered  
8 and acted upon as efficiently and expeditiously as possible;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of  
10 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That all bills,  
11 joint resolutions, joint memorials, and concurrent resolutions  
12 introduced in the 2001 regular session or the 2001 first special  
13 session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature are reintroduced in the house  
14 in which they originated and shall retain the same number and be given  
15 the highest legislative status that they attained in the original house  
16 as shown by the official House and Senate dockets upon the adjournment  
17 SINE DIE of the first special session.
