Brief Description: *Updating procedures for actions against driving school licensees.*

Brief Summary of Bill

- *Technical corrections are made that allow suspension of driver training school or driver school instructor licenses when requirements for licensing are no longer met.*

Background:

The Department of Licensing issues licenses to driver training schools and to their instructors. Current law limits the authority of the department to suspend a school or instructor license.

This is Department of Licensing request legislation.

Summary of Bill:

Technical corrections are made to the statute authorizing the director of the Department of Licensing to suspend, revoke, deny, or refuse to renew the license of a driver training school or a driver school instructor that clarify these licenses can be suspended when the requirements for licensing are no longer met.
