- RCW 15.65.175 Issuing, amending, or terminating a marketing order—Limitation on public hearings or referendums. The director shall not be required to hold a public hearing or a referendum more than once in any twelve-month period on petitions to issue, amend, or terminate a commodity marketing order if any of the following circumstances are present:
- (1) The petition proposes to establish a marketing order or agreement for the same commodity;
- (2) The petition proposes the same or a similar amendment to a marketing order or agreement; or
- (3) The petition proposes to terminate the same marketing order or agreement. [2002 c 313 § 12.]
