

**RCW 49.36.100 Public employer collective bargaining agreements—  
Waiver of statutory rights.** (1) A public employer may not require a worker to waive any statutory right to make a claim arising out of state or federal law as a condition of settling a grievance under a collective bargaining agreement.

(2) "Public employer" has the same meaning as in RCW 49.44.170.
