## GLOSSARY

### **CLASSIFICATION CATEGORY**

Community offenders under the jurisdiction of the Office of Correctional Operations are classified under a system that is driven by an offender's risk, supervision authority, and the conditions of the sentence. Beginning on July 1, 2004, community custody violators housed in DOC facilities are included in the community corrections population.

### **COUNTY OF SUPERVISION**

The county in which the case is being supervised or administered.

### **CRIME TYPE**

The crime for which the offender is currently ordered to receive field service. In cases of multiple crimes, the most recent offense is presented.

### **PRISON STATUS**

Offenders may be supervised for sentences that require prison confinement (Post Prison) or no prison confinement (Non-Prison)

### **SPECIAL SENTENCE TYPE**

DOSA: Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative sentences are special sentences available to non-violent offenders who have drug treatment needs. This type of sentence provides for treatment in prison, follow up treatment in the community, and an abbreviated confinement sentence for offenders who successfully complete treatment.

FTOW: First-Time Offender Waiver sentences are a special sentencing alternative allowed under the Sentencing Reform Act. This type of sentence diverts offenders from prison.

SSOSA: Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative sentences are a special sentencing alternative available to certain types of sex offenders under the Sentencing Reform Act. This type of sentence diverts offenders from prison.

MISDEAN: Misdemeanor sentences supervised by the Department of Corrections are those that are sentenced out of Superior Courts.

FOS: From-Out-of-State sentences are supervised by Department of Corrections under an Inter-State Compact.

### **VIOLATION**

Offenders on field supervision have violation reports with a guilty finding recorded in the Offender Based Tracking System (OBTS) when they do not comply with the conditions of their supervision.

### **WORK RELEASE**

A supervisory program imposed on an offender who has been conditionally released from total confinement in an institution or on a parolee or probationer in need of increased supervision. Certain felons convicted after implementation of the Sentencing Reform Act may serve their term of partial confinement in a Department of Corrections work release facility. The program allows residents to work or attend educational programs during the day and be confined in the work release facility at night.
