The Public Disclosure Commission is pleased to provide you with its Access Performance Measures for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. This annual update, required by <u>RCW 42.17A.065</u>, measures the Commission's timeliness in providing campaign finance data and lobbying expenditure information to the public. The campaign finance data includes reports filed by political committees, 2023 candidates, lobbyists, and lobbyist employers.

<u>Performance Measure No. 1</u>: Amount of Time Elapsed Between Filing and Public Access to Report Campaign and lobbying data are available on the PDC's website within 24-hours of being electronically submitted. Paper filings – delivered in person or through the U. S. mail – are scanned and posted within one business day of receipt.
