RE: Section 601 – Fund Transfers (Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6001)

Section 1(g) of Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6001 authorizes the department to make transfers between projects if the amount being transferred does not exceed \$250,000 or 10 percent of the total project cost. Furthermore, any transfers made are to be reported quarterly to the Director of Financial Management, and the Chairs of the Legislative Transportation Committees. This letter transmits a summary of projects that have been administratively approved in the April 1, 2015 through June 30, 2015 timeframe.
