

WAC 388-14A-7630 What limited services does DCS provide? (1)

For intergovernmental cases, the division of child support (DCS) cooperates with requests for the following limited services:

- (a) Quick locate;
- (b) Service of process;
- (c) Assistance with discovery;
- (d) Assistance with genetic testing;
- (e) Teleconferenced hearings;
- (f) Administrative reviews;
- (g) High-volume automated administrative enforcement in interstate cases under section 466 (a)(14) of the act; and
- (h) Copies of court orders and payment records.

(2) DCS may also honor requests for other limited services as appropriate.
