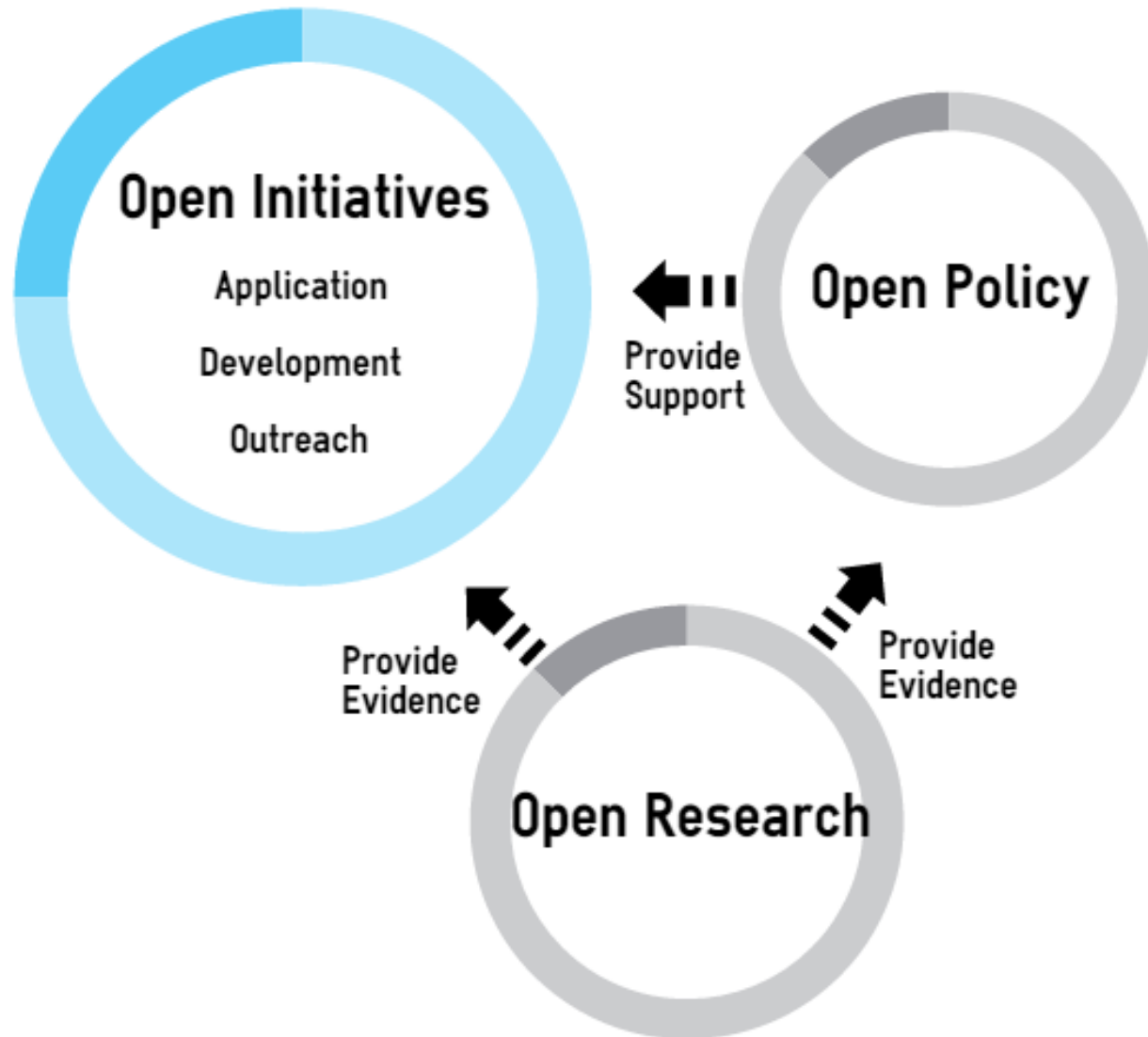
Open Educational Resources

- Open Educational Resources (OER) are the learning materials that you may freely use and reuse at no cost, and without needing to ask permission.
- They usually reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits their free use and repurposing by others.

Benefits of OER

- Saves students money
- Maintains student funds in Washington
- Designed for accessibility
- Keeps materials current
- Allows access before and after course

Open Licensing Policy

- “All works created by/through an SBCTC employee, contractor, or using grants funded and managed by the State Board are to be released under a **CC BY** license.”
