The following resolutions to instate an income tax have failed: 7 8 (1) House Joint Resolution No. 11 in 1934, failed with fifty-9 seven percent of the votes; (2) Senate Joint Resolution No. 7 in 1936, failed with seventy-10 11 eight percent of the votes; 12 (3) Senate Joint Resolution No. 5 in 1938, failed with sixty-13 seven percent of the votes; 14 (4) Constitutional Amendment Article VII, Section 2 in 1942, 15 failed with sixty-six percent of the votes; 16 (5) Initiative to the People No. 158 in 1944, failed with seventy 17 percent of the votes; (6) House Joint Resolution No. 42 in 1970, failed with sixty-18 19 eight percent of the votes; 20 (7) House Joint Resolution No. 37 in 1973, failed with seventy-21 seven percent of the votes; 22 (8) Initiative to the People No. 314 in 1975, failed with sixty-23 seven percent of the votes; (9) Initiative to the People No. 435 in 1982, failed with sixty-24 25 six percent of the votes; and 26 (10) Initiative to the People No. 1098 in 2010, failed with 27 sixty-four percent of the votes." 28 On page 28, beginning on line 25, after "alternative" strike all 29 material through "margins tax," on line 26

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1 On page 30, line 10, after "council." insert "Additionally, the 2 work group must uphold the will of the people and not recommend any 3 form of income tax."

<u>EFFECT:</u> Prohibits the tax structure work group from recommending any form of an income tax. Adds intent language related to income tax proposals.

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
