EFFECT:

- Removes an exemption from the requirement for a child twelve years old and under to wear a personal flotation device while on a vessel under nineteen feet in length that exempted a child on board a vessel at a time and place where no person would reasonably expect a danger of drowning to occur.
- Modifies the requirement for a person thirteen years old or

older to wear a personal flotation device while on board a vessel under nineteen feet in length as follows:

- o Removes the criteria that the vessel be under nineteen
 feet in length and instead requires the vessel to be
 "human-powered";
- Removes an exemption that exempted a person on board a vessel at a time and place where no person would reasonably expect a danger of drowning to occur;
- o Adds exemptions for the following persons:
 - Persons on board a squirt boat that is designed solely for squirt boating;
 - Persons on a stand-up paddle board that are wearing a leash that connects to the paddle board;
 - Persons participating in yoga on a stand-up paddle board in a designated swimming area or 100 feet from shore; and
 - Persons on a racing boat, shell, skull, or kayak that is designed solely for competitive racing.
