27 effect September 1, 2020.
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2 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 11. Sections 8 and 9 of this act take effect 3 July 1, 2021."

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<u>EFFECT:</u> (1) Makes the specified self-insurer penalties a maximum, rather than exact, amount.

(2) Refers to "penalties" rather than "minimum penalties" in the annual adjustment provision.

(3) Changes the new fiduciary duty to a responsibility of fair conduct, removes elements of a violation of the duty, and applies the responsibility to employers and their representatives instead of employers and their lay representatives.

(4) Requires issuance of an order by the Department of Labor and Industries regarding a violation within 90 ninety days, instead of within 30 days, of a request for an investigation.

(5) Adds effective dates of:

(a) September 1, 2020 for the sections increasing penalties; and(b) July 1, 2021 for the sections regarding fair conduct andlicensure of claims administrators.

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
