Initiative 502 to Legalize Adult-Use Cannabis Reflected:


- Disapproval of cannabis criminalization and inequitable harm to our communities
- Approval for regulating cannabis to make it safer and to sanction for adult-use
- Desire to eliminate the dangers of underground manufacturing
- Belief that cannabis offered wellness/therapeutic benefits beyond a single active constituent (cf. dronabinol)
- Support for research into the benefits AND/OR hazards of cannabis
- Understanding that there is much more to learn about cannabis and the oversight necessary to help protect public health and safety

What We Must Learn: delta-8 THC is psychotropic <u>and</u> posseses medicinal properties

- Marketed as "THC Lite"
 - Roughly 40% of the potency of Delta-9 THC from user reports
 - Not a 1-to-1 replacement for Delta-9 THC
- Binds Cannabinoid Receptors similar to but not the same as Delta-9 THC
 - CB1 Receptor: Delta-9 has 4X Greater Affinity than Delta-8 THC
 - CB2 Receptor: **Delta-8** has 4X Greater Affinity than Delta-9 THC
- Clinically-Studied For Reducing Nausea in Juvenile Cancer Patients
- Thermodynamically More Stable Than Delta-9 THC

What We Must Learn: delta-8 THC is not artificial

Who Can Help: our elected leaders
