Brief Background

- House Bill 2052 (2019)
 - Established a Cannabis Science Task Force to recommend lab quality standards.
 - Transferred the authority to set accreditation requirements from Liquor and Cannabis Board to Ecology in July 2024.






2020 Cannabis Science Task Force Report

Next Steps

- Continue work on other fields of testing through January 2022 and deliver a memo containing remaining recommendations to WSLCB
 - Microbial
 - Mycotoxins
 - Water activity/moisture
- Proposal for joint agency request legislation to form oversight body
 - Provide guidance/validation needed to implement flexibility
 - Assist with coordination among agencies with different jurisdictions
 - Coordinate an in-state Cannabis-Matrix Proficiency Testing Program
