EFFECT: Requires the Liquor and Cannabis Board (LCB) to assess cannabis retailer licenses based on one license per 15,000 residents statewide. Requires LCB to conduct and publish certain analyses and request the legislature increase retailer licenses if it determines new licenses should be made available. Limits expanding cannabis retailer licenses to counties that exceed one license per 10,000 residents.
