15 inform all such licensees and persons of how they may continue to be
16 notified of activities related to interstate cannabis agreements as
17 well as changes and proposed changes to laws and rules related to
18 this section and section 1 of this act, including statutory changes
19 identified in (b) of this subsection, rule changes identified in (d)
20 of this subsection, and agreements entered under this section; and

EFFECT: (1) Requires the coordination and enforcement of plans and actions related to interstate cannabis agreements to be consistent with Washington's policies and programs to redress inequities that exist from past cannabis prohibition and drug enforcement laws and to include steps to ensure equity in the application of agreements at all levels and in all jurisdictions that may interact with the licensed and unlicensed production and sale of cannabis.

(2) Requires the Liquor and Cannabis Board to provide notice of the effective date of the bill's authorization for the Governor to enter into agreements with other states concerning cross-jurisdictional cannabis activities to all cannabis licensees and pending applicants, and to inform them of how they may continue to be

notified of activities and changes and proposed changes to laws and rules related to interstate cannabis agreements.
