2 "The following resident and nonresident recreational fishing fee  
3 amounts are phased in as follows:

4 (a) From July 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026, resident and  
5 nonresident fee amounts are 72% of the amounts in the fee table in  
6 this section;

7 (a) From April 1, 2026 through March 31, 2027, resident and  
8 nonresident fee amounts are 79% of the amounts in the fee table in  
9 this section;

10 (b) From April 1, 2027 through March 31, 2028, resident and  
11 nonresident fee amounts are 86% of the amounts in the fee table in  
12 this section;

13 (c) From April 1, 2028 through March 31, 2029, resident and  
14 nonresident fee amounts are 93% of the amounts in the fee table in  
15 this section; and

16 (d) Beginning April 1, 2029, resident and nonresident fee amounts  
17 are the full amounts in the fee table in this section."

19 On page 22, after line 16, insert the following:

20 "The following resident and nonresident hunting fee amounts are  
21 phased in as follows:

22 (a) From July 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026, resident and  
23 nonresident fee amounts are 72% of the amounts in the fee table in  
24 this section;

25 (a) From April 1, 2026 through March 31, 2027, resident and  
26 nonresident fee amounts are 79% of the amounts in the fee table in  
27 this section;

1 (b) From April 1, 2027 through March 31, 2028, resident and  
2 nonresident fee amounts are 86% of the amounts in the fee table in  
3 this section;

4 (c) From April 1, 2028 through March 31, 2029, resident and  
5 nonresident fee amounts are 93% of the amounts in the fee table in  
6 this section; and

7 (d) Beginning April 1, 2029, resident and nonresident fee amounts  
8 are the full amounts in the fee table in this section."
