
## **Historic Codes of Washington: From the Territorial Period to the Mid-Twentieth Century**





The earliest Laws of Washington, from the Territorial era, beginning in 1854. These volumes have been rebound.






Old leather-bound copies of the Laws of Washington Territory in the historic collection of the Office of the Code Reviser.




Hill's Statutes and Codes of Washington, published in 1891 was the first compilation of Washington law after attainment of statehood.


Ballinger's Codes and Statutes of Washington, published in October of 1897 by the Honorable Richard Ballinger, ex-judge of the Superior Court.


Remington & Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington, first published in 1910




Remington's Revised Statutes of Washington was used in the 20s, 30s, and 40s and was ultimately replaced by the official RCW compiled under Richard White's direction.




Another code produced by Frank Pierce, was used in the 1920s to the 1940s.
